

AT for Memory Loss

Course Description

The course is designed as an introduction for therapists, support workers and others involved in the care of a person with memory loss.

The workshop explores assistive technology and strategies to promote independence and to enable people to remain safe in their environment.

Areas covered include:

- Equipment to make everyday living easier
- Home environment and safety
- Medication management

- Identify and understand the benefits of assistive technology
- Apply knowledge of assistive technology to people with dementia
- Be aware of communication strategies that can assist people with dementia
- Understand how the home environment can support function for people with dementia and memory loss.
