Take your first steps towards a new and exciting career – apply for one of the 3 scholarships today.

Could you be an Assistive Technology Mentor?

To be considered you will:

- live with disability or care for a family member who does
- have experience using assistive technology
- have a passion for technology and for assisting others
- be an excellent communicator
- have regular access to a computer or laptop
- be able to attend 23 days of training in Blacktown (2-3 days per month) plus 100hrs of work placement based at Blacktown
- commit to completing the course, including additional work at home
- submit an application and, if shortlisted, attend a selection interview

If successful, by the end of June 2019 you could be one of only a handful of people in New South Wales qualified as an Assistive Technology Mentor.
