Course Description

This course provides the knowledge and skills to perform as an Assistive Technology Mentor. Assistive Technology Mentors assist and support people with disabilities and/or carers to make informed choices about their assistive technology and home modification needs.

Individuals who successfully complete this course will be able to; research suitable assistive technology and home modification options to meet the needs and goals of others; teach and support others to find assistive technology solutions for themselves; provide impartial information and guidance about assistive technology possibilities to support choice.

Entry Requirements

Entrants for the Certificate IV in Assistive Technology Mentoring course must;

- be a person with a disability or direct carer of a person with disability
- have a lived experience of assistive technology

Note: There are no entry requirements for learners wishing to complete an individual unit or groups of units.

Program

This course includes seventeen units of competence. These units are nationally recognised and if all assessment tasks are completed, will provide a Certificate IV in Assistive Technology Mentoring. At least 100 hours of work placement is also a requirement of this qualification. Units are;
